The Churches' Ministerial Counselling Service is seeking to appoint a new **Consultant** to offer responsive, expert, professional advice and guidance to all involved in this specialised Service.

Role

Counselling Consultants offer guidance to the Service as a whole on policy matters. They hold responsibility for the high professional standards of CMCS. They also advise individuals concerning matters that arise during the running of the Service, usually by email or telephone.

Consultants consider applications from counsellors wishing to join the CMCS Register.

Consultants are expected to attend three meetings of the Service's Steering Group and one Consultants' meeting per year. Attendance is requested at one or two other meetings per year. Other meetings are usually carried out remotely using telephone conferencing.

Requirements

Applicants must be experienced and accredited counsellors, and also experienced and qualified in clinical supervision. They must possess good IT skills.

Applicants must also be active members of a Christian church which is in membership with one of the main ecumenical bodies in Britain. This is a genuine role requirement.

Remuneration

Although service as a Consultant is considered to be voluntary, an honorarium of about £1500 a year is given in appreciation of the commitment and skills offered. Expenses are also covered.
